TI City Hall now accepts passport applications

Passport processing and photos available beginning June 5th

The City of Treasure Island is pleased to announce that it now accepts passport applications on behalf of the U.S. Department of State. U.S. citizens planning international travel may apply for their passports and passport renewals Monday through Friday from 9am to 4pm at Treasure Island City Hall, 120 108th Avenue.

The new passport service includes passport photos and all necessary applications to process and obtain a new or renew an American passport.

“Treasure Island’s passport application facility is one of only two passport offices on the barrier islands of Pinellas County,” said IT Director Mark Santos.

Santos said people who wish to apply for a passport or a passport renewal should visit the official State Department passport website first to find out documentation requirements and then set up an appointment at Treasure Island City Hall. Appointments are made by calling 727-547-4575.
